Dear Parents,

Another very busy short week has gone by. I have enjoyed visiting classes this week and seeing all the excellent work going on, not just in Maths and English but also in exciting topics such as China, Extreme Earth and Ancient Greece. We have also enjoyed another class Mass this week, and Year 5 began a programme of work called 'Music Lab.' Just this morning I have enjoyed seeing the children in their Rock Steady Music Club and I am pleased about the feedback I am receiving about our new Spanish Club.

Children enjoyed our VR Workshops this week and seemed very motivated by the experience. Thank you to Mrs Chandler for organising this event. Annie in Year 3 said this about the experience:


