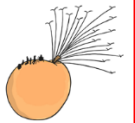
It was lovely to meet our new class today. We had a really lovely time and can't wait to get going in September.



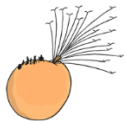
Please take time to read the welcome pack through with your child, particularly at the end of the summer holiday. This will really help your child with their transition into Dahl Class.



Our class webpage will be up and running from the beginning of the summer holiday. From September, it will be updated at the end of each week with information about what we've been up to and what's to follow.



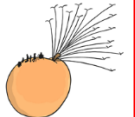
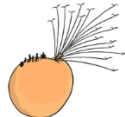

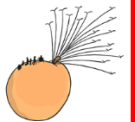
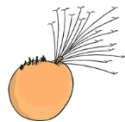
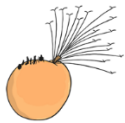
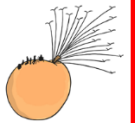
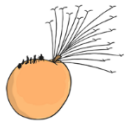




Transition Morning

4. I begin my quiet morning activity which will be on the whiteboard.

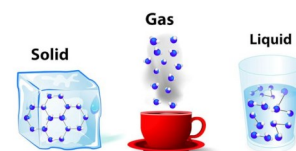
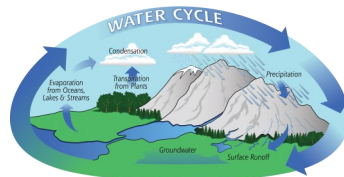
Summer Home Learning

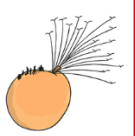
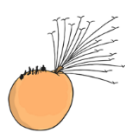
- Waterproof coat
