British Science Week.

What a busy week we have had! Foundation and KS1 were thrilled to see, and handle, animals from Dartmoor Zoo. Asking questions, discussing size and habitats have built on the learning that takes place in these year groups. Y3, Y4 and Y5 eyes filled with wonder as children entered the Spacelab Mobile Planetarium. Exploring light and space, the children consolidated their understanding within an exciting setting.

Y5 and Y6 travelled to the STEM Centre at Plymouth City College where they investigated microfossils, extracted DNA from fruit, tracked animals using scientific equipment and had quite a shock when they saw an interactive 3D heart pump in front of them!

Finally, Notre Dame students taught Y6 science on Friday. This provided our Y6 children with the chance to experience learning in a secondary school and embed their knowledge of science topics we have been learning about in class
