As we enter the 5th year of running the tour it seems a good time to reflect on its achievements.

Started from a thought from Brad on how we could do more to support families around the city that find the Summer Holiday so draining on finances the tour was born! It can only happen due to the ongoing support of our main suppliers and many local South West businesses who pledge produce for free and the CATERed staff who give up their holidays to prep, pack and give away the meals.

We started with 250 cold packed lunches every Tuesday and Thursday and now its 300 hot and cold meals with Lunch at the Library joining the tour 2 years ago. Making the weekly total 1200 – That's quite a lot isn't it! Through the donations received we were able to support other groups in the city as well last year – Millfield Inspired, Argyle Community Trust and Transforming Plymouth Together to name a few.

This year Plymouth City Councils Sports Development are going to run some activities at some of the dates and we would welcome any help from anyone in any school that would like to come along.

We will have a box of books on loan from the libraries and blankets so that where the weather is kind families can enjoy some lovely Plymouth fresh air and quality time with their children without worrying about the cost of the food. Rain does not stop the tour!
