

### WINTER FLU VACCINE—IMPORTANT NEWS

The nasal flu vaccine was due to be administered in school today 4th October, however due to a shortage in the vaccine, Virgin Health have had to postpone the vaccination date to **Thursday 5th December**. If you have signed consent for your child to be vaccinated, you do not need to do anything as consent will be carried forward. If you have not yet signed your child up to receive the vaccination, and now wish to do so, you can still sign up using the link below:

The closing date for providing online consent will close on Sunday 24th November. If you do not wish your child to have the vaccine, you do not need to do anything.




