In phonics this week we have been reviewing the sounds that have been previously taught, the sounds being reviewed are m, a and s ready for assessments next week, where the children will be put into new phonics groups. The children have especially enjoyed dressing up in bright colours to support the 'Be Bright and Be Seen' mufti day, we loved seeing their style and enjoyment from this.
