Message from the Headteacher

Dear Parents,

As I write this, the children (and parents) will be enjoying our Sports day. The weather certainly has come right for this special whole school event.

Most of the children have been doing NTS tests this week, as we were selected as a school to carry out national trials. Next week there will be further tests - our PIRA (Reading) and PUMA (Maths) tests that all CAST schools have done termly. These will help confirm the teachers' judgements on how your child has achieved this year.

Our Year 6 writing was moderated externally by the Local Authority on Monday and yesterday our end of Key Stage 1 assessments had the same scrutiny. It is good practice that 25% of Plymouth schools are moderated each year. I am delighted to note that the process not only agreed with our judgements, they also could see the rigorous approaches taken by the teachers to provide very strong evidence.

I would like to congratulate two of our pupils for recent achievements outside of school. Olivia (Year 3) is currently appearing at the Theatre Royal in **Les Misérables**. She is playing the part of the young Cosette. Last Friday Benjamin visited Windsor castle as a finalist for BBC's 500 Words competition. Whilst he was not the ultimate winner, he had a wonderful day.



Our Year 3 and 4 pupils visited the National Marine Aquarium this week as part of their topic work. They enjoyed all the learning that such an amazing place offers. We are lucky to be able to have such a resource in Plymouth.

It was great to see one of our governors, Father Jacek in school on Wednesday, being quizzed with 'I wonder...' questions by our Foundation Stage children. Some questions included:

How does God talk to us?

Is Jesus in his own heart?

Why did Jesus die at Easter?

How can you get people to trust that God made us?
