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Let's keep kids safe online

A letter has been sent home this week regarding a free workshop for parents and carers to attend. The aim of the workshop is to provide parents and carers with useful tools, support and guidance to help their children and families stay safe online. The hour long workshop will be held at the following:

- Thursday 23rd November 2pm – Cathedral School
- Thursday 23rd November 4pm – Holy Cross School

Plymouth City Council's Fit and Fed project has been shortlisted for Tesco 'Bags of Help' funding. Fit and Fed aims to fight holiday hunger, isolation and inactivity by providing young people with affordable holiday provision. This year Tesco have engaged with 266 different students from all across the city, many of whom access free school meals during term time.

Each time you make a purchase at any Tesco store you will receive a token. If you could place the token in the right hand voting box marked "Plymouth City Council - Fit and Fed Project" on exit of the store, your vote will be counted towards securing further funding. Voting is open from 1 November 2017 until 1 January 2018 in all Plymouth Stores.

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Kidzklub is held at Plymouth Christian Centre on Friday evenings during term time between 5.45 and 7.15pm. It has a programme packed with multimedia, music and songs, competitions and games, drama and great stories, all presented from a Christian viewpoint. It is all free of charge. There is an opportunity for parents to come and join us in a coffee lounge during the programme. An area where grownups can bring younger siblings and relax and enjoy tea, coffee and biscuits. All while their older children are being entertained in the Kidzklub and youth programme. You are also welcome to take your coffee into the balcony area and watch the fun downstairs! 
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Your Opinion matters
