

There are 32 parent accounts who owe the school over £10. Whilst I would not want to stop a child from having a school dinner, attend before or after school clubs, or have to cancel a school trip through lack of funds, the school should not be waiting considerable periods of time for these debts to be paid. It should not be the task of office staff to be chasing this money so I would ask any accumulated debts to be paid by the end of this month and in future for these not to occur. We do not have the capacity to hold debt, so this cannot continue.

Next week we have more Science and Art students in, trips to the cinema and Buckfast, and a Penitential Service.
