Lego Science Electric workshop -

Lower Key Stage Two enjoyed a wonderful day of science earlier this week. Here is a report from Miss Cairns:

'In years 3 and 4 we were lucky enough to have visitors in to deliver a Lego science workshop. First the children were asked to build a Lego village in teams. They were then taught how to make an electrical circuit to illuminate their village using elements such as batteries and bulbs. They discussed lots of interesting things such as why the bulbs become dimmer when more than one is connected to a single battery. They then added a motorised railway track to their village and discussed how it works. We all had an amazing time and we can't wait to learn more about electricity in our science lessons.'

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Plymouth Youth Sports Trust would like to invite you to an information morning at Plymouth Life Centre on Wednesday 22nd November between 10am – 12pm.




