Dear Parents/Carers,

It has been so lovely to have all the children back at school. Understandably the return to school was tricky for some as they had become used to being at home with you but they did extremely well and by the end of the week everyone seemed to have settled back into the routine and structure of the school day. It has been wonderful to see how well they have applied themselves to their learning although there were many tired hands on Monday!

The teachers planned opportunities for the children to learn collaboratively and also ensured that the children had time to reconnect with one another. The children have been so excited to see one another and to once again, be able to play together in the playground – remembering to social distance as much as possible.

You will be aware that the Year 2 and Year 6 SATs have been cancelled but our focus on preparing children for the next step of their education remains a key priority for us; whether it is preparing Year 6 for secondary school or preparing our Foundation Stage children for their move to KS1. Assessment is on-going and teachers are experts at identifying gaps in learning so that they can plan and address those gaps. Please be reassured that the teachers at Holy Cross will be working extremely hard to ensure that your children are ready to move to the next year group in September.

The summer term is traditionally the term for Sports Days, residentials, Class trips/visits, Summer Fayres etc. At the moment these are not yet possible. We hope that if the Prime Minister's road plan 'goes to plan', that we will be able to look at the possibility of these events. It may be however that due to the short notice and the need to plan these so far in advance, prohibits them from happening but we will do what we can.

Staggered Drop offs and Pick ups

Please note that no cars should drive down White Friars Lane.

There have been a large number of Year 5/6 children arriving early as they walk to school. To keep them safe, we need to allow them onto the playground which is difficult under these circumstances. Please could we ask that they don't leave home too early.

Masks/Face coverings

Symptomatic of COVID-19

If your child presents with a new continuous cough, a fever or is experiencing any loss of or change in their taste/smell, please do not send them to school.

If your child presents with any of these symptoms while at school, you should have your child tested and the whole household should self-isolate until you get the result. Further action will depend on the result of the test.

LFD Testing

The government is now offering this same opportunity to parents of any school age child. Please visit this website for further detail. lateral-flow-testing-for-households If you have a positive LFT result, please inform the school at this email covid@holycross.plymouth.sch.uk

You and your household will need to self-isolate so you should not send your child(ren) to school.

You should then book a PCR test.

If the PCR test is positive, you should continue to self-isolate as a household for 10

If the result of the PCR test is negative, the children may return to school. Please email us to let us know the result of the PCR.
