The children in Year 1 and 2 were able to start back again this week and have bounced into school everyday, ready to learn and to re-connect with one another and with their teachers; and our KS2 children have settled back brilliantly too, enjoying their learning and settling quickly into new routines and habits. The staff have been fantastic too and I am very excited to have the opportunity to work with such a dedicated and hard-working team. We all want the best for your children and will work hard together to provide a safe, happy and enriching environment where each child can flourish. What is important now, after such a long spell away from school, is that your children once again feel secure and are ready to learn. Our Recovery Curriculum is very much a layered approach focusing simultaneously on the children's emotional needs and mental wellbeing; identifying and addressing the gaps in their learning and engaging and challenging them with new learning.

Please try to stick to your allocated drop off time in the morning. On average we have between 4 and 7 children arriving late every day. As the children need to remain in their bubbles, they cannot enter by reception and it means staff need to be called out of class to collect them.
