SYMPTOMS OF COVID-19

COVID-19 Case Definition: (as of 18/05/20)

- A high temperature
- A new, continuous cough
- A loss of, or change to, your sense of smell or taste

SUSPECTED case in child

If your child has any one of the symptoms of COVID-19, they should remain **AT HOME**.

If your child displays any of these symptoms while at school, you will be contacted to collect them **immediately**. They will be isolated from the rest of their group in the meantime, with a member of staff to support them.

Arrange to have your child tested.

Result of Test?

POSITIVE for COVID-19

Negative for COVID-19

School will notify authorities and engage in 'Track and Trace'.

Your child needs to isolate at home for **11 days** (day of onset of symptoms + 10 days)

The rest of your household should isolate for **14 days**.

Child can return when feeling well.
Family can stop self-isolating and carry on as normal.

Your child needs to isolate at home for **8 days** (day of onset of symptoms + 7 days)

The rest of your household should isolate for **14 days**.

Rest of the child's bubble will be sent home and advised to self-isolate for 14 days.

Any contact displaying symptoms should get tested.

Child can return to school once the isolation period is completed.
